

# IDENTISPPOOL

If you have a vintage camera and you're unsure about what film type it used, it will be hard to know what adapter it needs to load 120 film. This guide will help you identify if the correct spool for your 116, 616, 118, or 122 film camera.

The colored parts are the FAK adapters that once mounted on a 120 film spool will make it the size of the vintage spool. Just measure the height of the film slot in your camera and compare it with the table below. Note that 116 and 616 spools are the same height, but have very different flanges: if you're in doubt, take a measure of the film advance interlocking.
